I. Call to Order, Announcements, and Disclosures

Dr. DuCoin called the meeting to order and read the Chair script. The disclosure document was circulated for updates or confirmation as appropriate. As chair, Dr. DuCoin, ensured all contributions are balanced during the committee meeting and asked that in addition to noting them in the printed document, if anyone has any new or changed disclosures, to please log into your SAGES member account as soon as possible and update them there as well.

II. Approval of Minutes

The minutes from the Fall 2024 meeting on October 15, 2024 were approved.

III. Review Committee Goals

The committee reviewed and discussed the goals individually. They discussed how to reach out for funding without overreaching the SAGES' broader requests. Given the limited availability of funding, members emphasized the importance of demonstrating value in how grants are used.

They also addressed creating opportunities for groups with less access to research, like community surgeons. To facilitate collaborations, they outlined the criteria for the mentorship program that would pair residents with experienced researchers.

The committee emphasized the importance of marketing and visibility for the research opportunities and discussed an updated strategy for the Career Development Award recipient follow-up.

IV. 2025 Grants

70 grant submissions were received for the 2025 year. Dr. DuCoin went over the COI policies and the review expectations of committee members leading to a broader discussion about COI and the grant review process. Members noted situations during which reviewers need to recuse themselves.

The committee agreed that if a member, or anyone from their institution, submitted a grant, they are not eligible to review in that category.
